## SARAH GOODMAN OUR MEDICAL MISSIONARY TO THE AMAZON

Dear Friends,

Thank you for your ongoing prayers and support! I am grateful to report my support is approximately 95%!

At the end of May, the Lord allowed me to take part in the first of two planned medical missions trips to the Amazon. The first included 30 team members in addition to 3 national pastors and 3 local missionary families. We hosted medical clinics in 6 villages with 673 individuals coming through. We rejoice over the 51 individual salvation decisions that were made during these clinics! As a special blessing, I was able to use my wound care training to provide care for several patients with prominent wounds. This included a severe hand burn as well as the removal of a botfly larva from an infected tropical ulcer.

The final night of this trip included a divine appointment I was not expecting. While visiting with a missionary friend, we heard a loud crash outside of her home. We found two teenage girls had just crashed their motorcycle. Although both girls were not seriously injured, they still suffered multiple abrasions and were very shaken up and scared. While treating their scrapes, we were able to talk with them and share the Gospel. The sisters were tearful and eagerly listened to the entire presentation. They seemed to understand the gravity of the situation and just how much God had protected them. The oldest sister, Luci, seemed especially interested in the verses. Unfortunately, before they had a chance to make a decision, the family arrived to get them. Please pray for them that God’s Word would not go void in their lives.

Again, thank you for your support that has allowed me to go to the Amazon. As the Apostle Paul said it is truly “fruit that may abound to your account.”
