JOSEPH AS A VICTIM (Gen 37:23-33)

STRIPPED JOSEPH OF HIS ROBE (23) *And it came to pass, when Joseph was come unto his brethren, that they stript Joseph out of his coat, his coat of many colors that was on him;*

STUCK HIM IN A PIT (24) *and they took him and cast him into a pit: and the pit was empty, there was no water in it.*

SAT DOWN TO EAT (25-27)

WHAT THEY SAW (25) *And they sat down to eat bread: and they lifted up their eyes and looked, and behold, a company of Ishmeelites came from Gilead with their camels bearing spicery and balm and myrrh, going to carry it down to Egypt.*

Ishmeelites (25,27)

Midianites (28)

WHAT THEY SAID (26-27) *And Judah said unto his brethren, What profit is it if we slay our brother, and conceal his blood? ²⁷ Come, and let us sell him to the Ishmeelites, and let not our hand be upon him; for he is our brother and our flesh. And his brethren were content.*

SOLD HIM AS A SLAVE (28) *Then there passed by Midianites merchantmen; and they drew and lifted up Joseph out of the pit, and sold Joseph to the Ishmeelites for twenty pieces of silver: and they brought Joseph into Egypt.*

SOILED HIS COAT OF MANY COLORS (31) *And they took Joseph's coat, and killed a kid of the goats, and dipped the coat in the blood;*

SENT THE COAT TO THEIR FATHER (32) *and they sent the coat of many colors, and they brought it to their father; and said*

SAID HE HAD BEEN KILLED (32-33)

DECEIVED WITH THE COAT (32) *This have we found: know now whether it be thy son's coat or no.*

DECEIVED WITH THE COMMENTS (33) *And he knew it, and said, It is my son's coat; an evil beast hath devoured him; Joseph is without doubt rent in pieces.*

Joseph As Victim (#2) Gen 37:26-28, 32-36

JOSEPH'S NEW LIFE (37:26-28)

Sold to the Ishmeelites (aka - Midianites) (28) ²⁸ *Then there passed by Midianites merchantmen; and they drew and lifted up Joseph out of the pit, and sold Joseph to the Ishmeelites for twenty pieces of silver: and they brought Joseph into Egypt.*

Sold to an Egyptian (36) *And the Midianites sold him into Egypt unto Potiphar, an officer of Pharaoh's, and captain of the guard.*

JACOB'S NEW LIFE (32-35)

HIS ACTIONS (33b-34) *It is my son's coat; an evil beast hath devoured him; Joseph is without doubt rent in pieces. And Jacob rent his clothes, and put sackcloth upon his loins, and mourned for his son many days.*

THE EXTERNAL (34abc)

An Instant Reaction (34a) *And Jacob rent his clothes,*

An Obvious Demonstration (34b) *and put sackcloth upon his loins*

THE INTERNAL (34c) *and mourned for his son many days.*

HIS ATTITUDE (35)

HE REFUSED HIS FAMILY'S COMFORT

(35a) *And all his sons and all his daughters rose up to comfort him; but he refused to be comforted;*

HE REHEARSED HIS FATHERLY GRIEF

(35b) *and he said, For I will go down into the grave unto my son mourning. Thus his father wept for him.*

2 Sam 18:32-33 – (David) - *And the king said unto Cushi, Is the young man Absalom safe? And Cushi answered, The enemies of my lord the king, and all that rise against thee to do thee hurt, be as that young man is. ³³ And the king was much moved, and went up to the chamber over the gate, and wept: and as he went, thus he said, O my son Absalom, my son, my son Absalom! would God I had died for thee, O Absalom, my son, my son!*
