



TEACHING CHILDREN TO WORSHIP DOES NOT MEAN "TO SIT QUIETLY"

Why is it so important to teach our children to worship? Isn't it enough that they just sit and don't disturb others?

Well...The word "worship" is used over 180 times in the Bible. Over and over again, we are commanded to worship, sing, and give praise. Worship is what we were created to do. It is how we show our devotion to God and express our love and gratitude to Him, and it is the key to our relationship with him.

We need to ask ourselves if we are training our children to worship the Lord at church or telling them to just sit quietly until the service is over.

Training children to worship is best when it is taught by mom and dad and lived out with the children worshipping side by side with their parents. Here are a few ways we can train our children to worship at church:

- Hold the hymnal and follow along with your finger or point to the words on the screen.
- Don't use your phones, laptop, tablets or ipads; use the Bible.
- Lead by example.

Teaching children to worship and not just sit quietly does NOT happen by accident. It takes time and intention.

Here at First Baptist Church, we have a Junior Church service at 10:30 which patterns the regular church service in the auditorium. However, the evening service is the time for our children to sit with adults and learn to worship God.
