THE HENDRICKS FAMILY THAT ZAMBIANS MAY KNOW HIM

Dear Praying friends,

We are growing excited as our time of departure gets closer. We have had several churches partner with us in the months since our last letter, and this puts us closer to our goal every day!

As our hearts expand with anticipation for our move, they are also saddened because of the current state of Zambia. As a result of a severe drought this year, Zambians are currently experiencing shortages of food, water, and electricity because all their power comes from an outdated dam on the border of Zambia and Zimbabwe. This drought is so bad that it is even affecting the well at the farm where our house is. We are praying that God will supply the finances to allow us to drill about 200 feet deeper. Pray this drought will open the eyes and soften the hearts for the people to realize their need for a Savior.

We are beginning to look for transportation for when we get to the field because we will need it immediately. Our partners on the field have found one in great condition at a fantastic price. Pray with us that the Lord will provide the funds for this vehicle. If you feel lead to give toward fixing the well or the purchase of our vehicle fund, please send contributions to our mission board BIO marked 7335-Hendricks and designate either well or car.

The devil is fighting to keep us from getting to Zambia, but our hope is in the God Who called us and has knitted our hearts to the people of Zambia. Therefore, we will preserve and cannot begin to thank all of you who contribute, but more importantly, cover our family and our ministry in prayer!
