Galatians 1:10-24 - <u>PAUL'S DEFENSE OF THE GOSPEL</u> Sept 18, 2024 (Lesson #4) (Gal 1:10-16)

(Gal 1:1, 4-5, 6-9)

THE MAN - (Gal 1:1-3)

THE AUTHOR - (1:1a) Paul, an apostle,

THE AUTHORITY - (1:1b) (not of men, neither by man, but by Jesus Christ, and God the Father, who raised him from the dead;)

THE ASSOCIATES - (1:2a) "All the brethren which are with me."

THE ADDRESSEES - (1:2b) unto the churches of Galatia

THE ACTION - (1:3) "grace and peace unto you."

THE MESSAGE - (Gal 1:4-5)

INVOLVES SUBSTITUTION (4a) "Who gave himself for our sins"
INVOLVES DELIVERANCE (4b) "that he might deliver us from this present evil world"
INVOLVES THE WILL OF GOD (4c) "according to the will of God and our Father"
INVOLVES THE GLORY OF GOD (5) "To whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen."

THE MEANS / METHODS (at work) (Gal 1:6-9)

THE DECEPTION OF THE PEOPLE - (Gal 1:6-7)

THEIR INSTABILITY (6) I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel:

THEIR IGNORANCE (7) Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ.

FALSE GOSPEL- A DIFFERENT DOCTRINE
FALSE MOTIVES - THE DEVIANT TEACHERS
Corrupted The Message, Confused The People, Changed The Doctrine

THE DECEPTION BY THE PREACHERS - (Gal 1:8-9)

THE MESSENGER (8) But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.

THE MESSAGE (9) As we said before, so say I now again, If any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.

PAUL'S MESSAGE WAS FROM GOD (Gal 1:10-16a) For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ.

11 But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man.

12 For I neither received it of man, neither was I taught it, but by the revelation of Jesus Christ.

PAUL'S PERSONAL CONVICTION (Gal 1:10) (Serving only Christ) For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet, pleased men I should not be the servant of Christ.

PAUL'S PRESENT CONFESSION (Gal 1:11-12) (Speaking only for Christ)

<u>HE DID NOT TEACH ACCORDING TO ANY HUMAN STANDARD</u> (1:11) But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man. <u>HE DID NOT RECEIVE HIS GOSPEL FROM ANY HUMAN SOURCE</u> (1:12a) For I

<u>DID NOT RECEIVE HIS GOSPEL FROM ANY HUMAN SOURCE</u> (**1:12a**) For I neither received it of man,

(Acts 9). Ananias called him "brother Saul" (Acts 9:17). (Acts 9:9,19-20).

<u>HE WAS NOT TAUGHT BY ANY APOSTLE</u> (12b) neither was I taught it, (Acts 22:3)

HE WAS TAUGHT BY DIRECT REVELATION FROM CHRIST HIMSELF (12c) but by the revelation of Jesus Christ.

PAUL'S PAST CONDUCT - (Gal 1:13-14) (Standing against Christ)

HE PERSECUTED THE CHURCH (1:13) For ye have heard of my conversation in time past in the Jews' religion, how that beyond measure I persecuted the church of God, and wasted it:

Acts 8:1 "Saul was consenting unto his (Stephen's) death."

Acts 9:1 "breathing out threatenings and slaughter against the disciples of the Lord."

Acts 26:9-11 "I verily thought with myself, that I ought to do many things contrary to the name of Jesus of Nazareth. ¹⁰ Which thing I also did in Jerusalem: and many of the saints did I shut up in prison, having received authority from the chief priests; and when they were put to death, I gave my voice against them. ¹¹ And I punished them oft in every synagogue, and compelled them to blaspheme; and being exceedingly mad against them, I persecuted them even unto strange cities."

Acts 9:4 "Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me?"
The church is "The body of Christ." (1 Cor. 12:13, Eph. 1:22-23, 4:4, 5:29-32)

<u>HE PRACTICED RELIGIOUS TRADITIONS</u> (14) And profited in the Jews' religion above many my equals in mine own nation, being more exceedingly zealous of the traditions of my fathers.

- 1 He "profited in the Jews' religion."
- 2 He was zealous in the traditions of the Jews' religion.

Phil 3:5-6 "Circumcised the eighth day, of the stock of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, an Hebrew of the Hebrews; as touching the law, a Pharisee; ⁶ Concerning zeal, persecuting the church; touching the righteousness which is in the law, blameless."

PAUL'S PERSONAL CONVERSION (Gal 1:13a, 15-16) (His salvation by Christ)

GOD SEPARATED HIM (15ab) But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb,

GOD CALLED HIM (15c-16) (it pleased God, who) ... called me by his grace, GOD COMMISSIONED HIM (16b) called me by his grace,

(Acts 9:15) "He is a chosen vessel unto me, to bear my name before the Gentiles, and kings, and the children of Israel."

(Acts 13-21) (Acts 16:10-12)
