THE DESIGN OF THE CUP TEST - Gen 44

THE ACCUSATION (Gen 44:1-8) And Joseph commanded the steward of his house, saying, Fill the men's sacks with food, as much as they can carry, and put every man's money in his sack's mouth. ² And put my cup, the silver cup, in the sack's mouth of the youngest, and his corn money. And he did according to the word that Joseph had spoken. ³ As soon as the morning was light, the men were sent away, they and their asses. ⁴ And when they were gone out of the city, and not yet far off, Joseph said unto his steward, Up, follow after the men; and when thou dost overtake them, say unto them, Wherefore have ye rewarded evil for good? 5 Is not this it in which my lord drinketh, and whereby indeed he divineth? ye have done evil in so doing. ⁶And he overtook them, and he spake unto them these same words. ⁷ And they said unto him, Wherefore saith my lord these words? God forbid that thy servants should do according to this thing: 8 behold, the money, which we found in our sacks' mouths, we brought again unto thee out of the land of Canaan; how then should we steal out of thy lord's house silver or gold?

THE REACTION (Gen 44:9-12)

(44:9) "With whomsoever of thy servants it be found, both let him die, and we also will be my lord's bondmen."

Gen 44:11-12Then they speedily took down every man his sack to the ground, and opened every man his sack. ¹² And he searched, and began at the eldest, and left at the youngest: "

THE TACTICAL USE OF THE CUP

Gen 44:5 the cup was used "to divine."

Gen 44:15 Joseph claimed the ability to divine: To Divine = to discover, discern information that was not available by normal means.

Gen 44:12b the cup was found in Benjamin's sack -

Gen 44:13 "they rent their clothes"

Gen 44:14-17 -And Judah and his brethren came to Joseph's house; for he was yet there: and they fell before him on the ground. ¹⁵ And Joseph said unto them, What deed is this that ye have done? wot ye not that such a man as I can certainly divine? ¹⁶ And Judah said, What shall we say unto my lord? what shall we speak? or how shall we clear ourselves? God hath found out the iniquity of thy servants: behold, we are my lord's servants, both we, and he also with whom the cup is found. ¹⁷ And he said, God forbid that I should do so: but the man in whose hand the cup is found, he shall be my servant; and as for you, get you up in peace unto your father.

The sentence was passed – slavery for Benjamin dismissal to Canaan for the 10 brothers

Heb 2:14-15 "deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage."
