THE REACTION - THE BROTHERS' FEAR

THE CIRCUMSTANCE (15) "And when Joseph's brethren saw that their father was dead, they said, Joseph will peradventure hate us, and will certainly requite us all the evil which we did unto him

THE CONCERNS (15ab)

JOSEPH WOULD HATE THEM (15a) they said, Joseph will peradventure hate us,

JOSEPH WOULD REPAY THEM (15b) and will certainly requite us

THE CAUSE (15c) (for) all the evil which we did unto him

THE CIRCUMVENTION ATTEMPT (16-18)

<u>THE INSTRUCTION</u> (16) And they sent a messenger unto Joseph, saying, **Thy father** did command before he died, saying,

THE ATTRIBUTION (17ab) So shall ye say unto Joseph, **Forgive**, I pray thee now, **the trespass** of thy brethren, and their **sin**; for they did unto thee **evil**: and now, we pray thee, forgive the trespass of the servants of the God of thy father.
