Dear Praying friends,

We are praising the Lord for an amazing start to our children's outreach and feeding program. For our first week, we had 33 children in attendance. We are so thankful for our volunteers who have helped us with activity time and the cooking. We have already noticed several children who always come hungry. Pray we can continue to help them through the feeding program. We are thankful for this ministry as it gives us insight into our future orphanage.

We continue to look for property for the orphanage. We were told of 3 lots equaling 1,500 square meters next to the church that might be available for sale. However, after more investigation, we were told they were only selling one of the lots (500 square meters) at this time. This property would be a great start for the orphanage, large enough to house 10 to 15 orphans, especially since it is connected to our church property. Please join us in praying the owners will change their minds and make all the property for sale.

Please continue to pray for our visas. Pray that God will guide us to the right officials, and in His perfect timing we will be granted our visas so we can return to the United States for our furlough.

Pray for our church (Bantayan First Baptist Church) as we prepare for our annual Thanksgiving service. We voted last week to install air conditioning in our church for this year's project. Our church has agreed to make pledges for this need. Pray for God's provision and installment before October.
