This week while home alone, one of our members got something lodged in her throat and was unable to breathe. Gasping for air and about to pass out, she prayed, and God brought to mind a time years before when she felt this same way at a church supper. Back then someone rushed to her rescue by performing the Heimlich Maneuver on her. Now alone, she used forceful action against her own abdomen and was able to dislodge the object and breathe. Because of this incident, we are reminded how important it is to know how to do this on yourself.

It is essentially the same Heimlich maneuver you would perform on another person. Make a fist with one hand and put the thumb side between your belly button and rib cage. Place you other hand on top of that. Then push as hard as you can in a quick motion straight into your abdomen. This will put pressure on the bottom of your diaphragm which will compress your lungs and force the remaining air to push up through your trachea with enough force to dislodge the object.

BERHANU & WUBIT YOSEPH OUR MISSIONARIES TO EAST AFRICA

Dear Praying Friends,

Last weekend we were down south to conduct an evangelistic tent meeting n a place called Jido. We arrived a few days early to prepare, going from house to house to invite people. This work was not easy, and while doing it we had confrontations with Muslim leaders. One Muslim sheikh even threw a stone and hit one of our preachers on the forehead. No one responded in anger; we kept calm so the situation would not worsen.

The next day, something unexpected happened. The very same sheikh who threw the stone came to us and said he had made a big mistake. He told us he had the worse night of his life. After we spoke with him about Jesus the Messiah, he accepted the Lord and began to attend the conference.

During our few days there we also had the privilege of showing the Jesus Film. Over 100 people saw it. Many children wanted to come, but some families came into the tent, grabbed their children, and beat them badly for being there. Because of the danger, we invited people to salvation privately, not publicly, to protect the new believers and ourselves. During the conference, 7 people accepted the Lord secretly. In three days after the conference, 5 more people have accepted the Lord.

Brother Temam, a former Muslim imam, gave a powerful testimony during the conference. He told the people," You know how I used to be a troublemaker in this village. I fought with many of you because of the hatred in my heart. Now, though, I am free from all that hatred. I assure you; I love you all".

Thank you for sending funds to help us build these church buildings. The opposition we face is beyond what I can describe, but God's blessings have been greater than the hardships.
