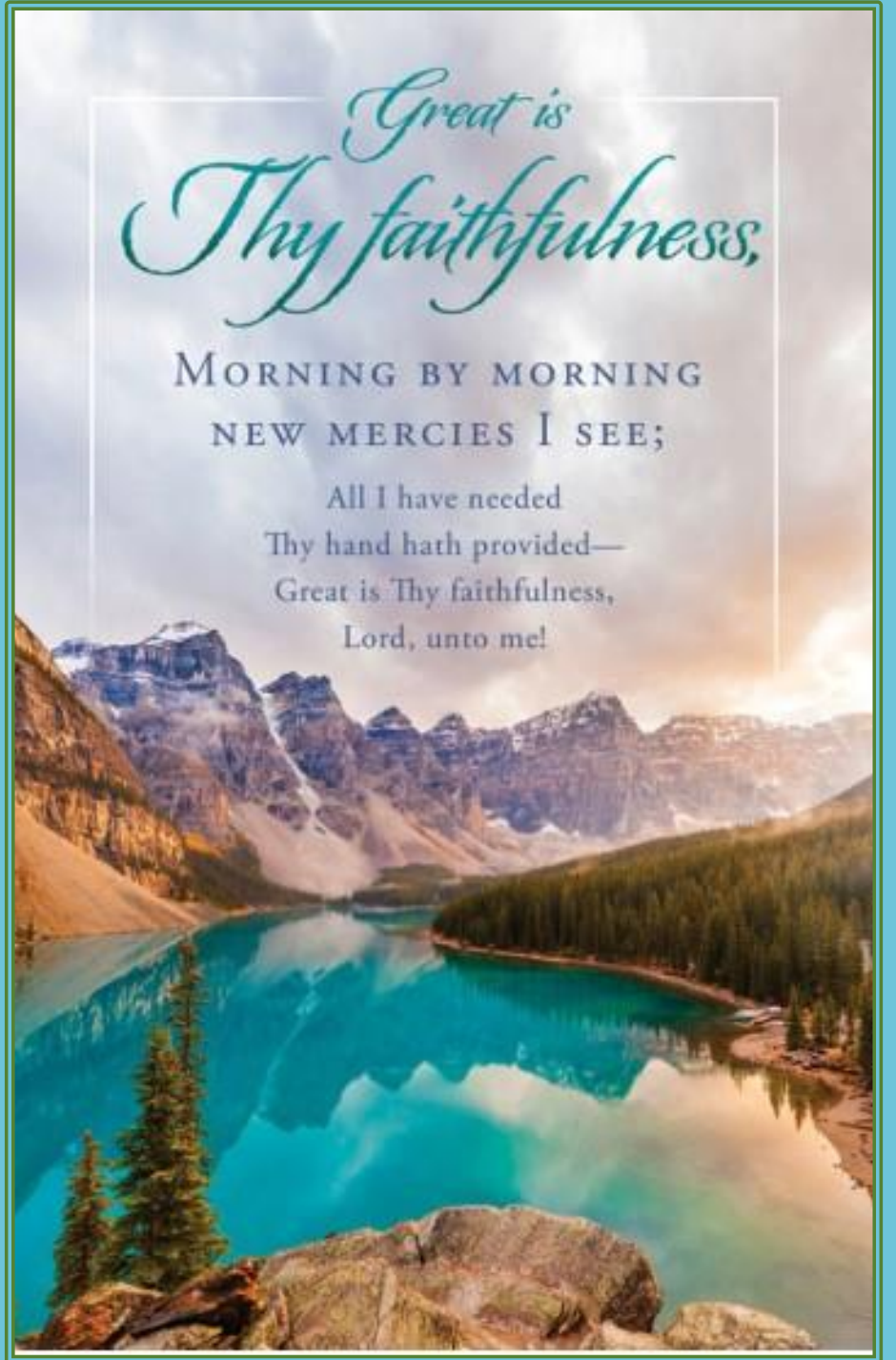

KIDS' ACTIVITIES

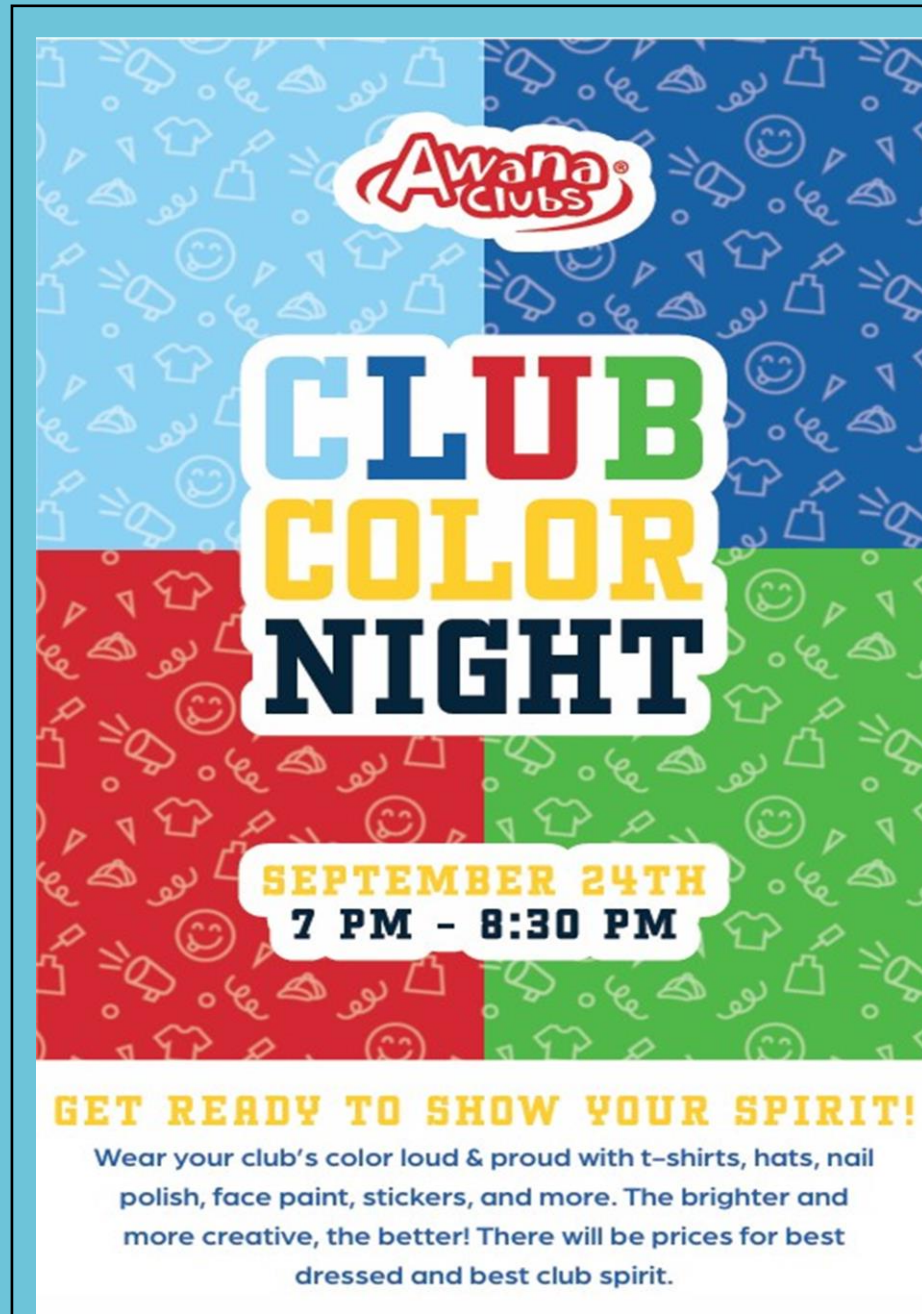
Tonight, after church, all families with kids in the home are invited to a S.N.A.C. ATTACK!

CHURCH PLANTING IN MOZAMBIQUE, AFRICA

As we continue to make more progress in our language learning, we are finding new opportunities to work and minister in Mozambique. This is a real blessing because it enables us to function in society while also providing an opportunity to minister to the people of Mozambique.

On August 9th, we began a Bible study in an area of the city called Zimpeto. Since then, we have met for the Bible study two more times. The goal of the Bible study is to provide a space where we can practice language and ministry skills while also preparing for the future, as this Bible study could potentially become our first church plant. Thank you for praying as we seek to reach souls each week with the gospel.

As language comes, so come more and new ministry opportunities. Toward the end of August, I began a class at the Bible Institute of our friend, Bro. Lopez. He is a faithful missionary from Mexico who is working here. We are grateful for the opportunity to serve and teach at the Bible Institute of his church.

In August, I preached every Sunday morning at the church where we are currently serving. It is a challenge to prepare and preach in Portuguese, but the Lord is continually giving us more freedom and liberty in Portuguese.

One evening, before church on Thursday, I was talking on the street to a man named Osvaldo. After a few minutes of talking, I shared the gospel with him. We examined the Scriptures together. Osvaldo told me he had never heard the gospel. Praise the Lord, Osvaldo accepted Jesus Christ as his Savior. Please pray for Osvaldo that he would grow spiritually and remain faithful in the Lord.
