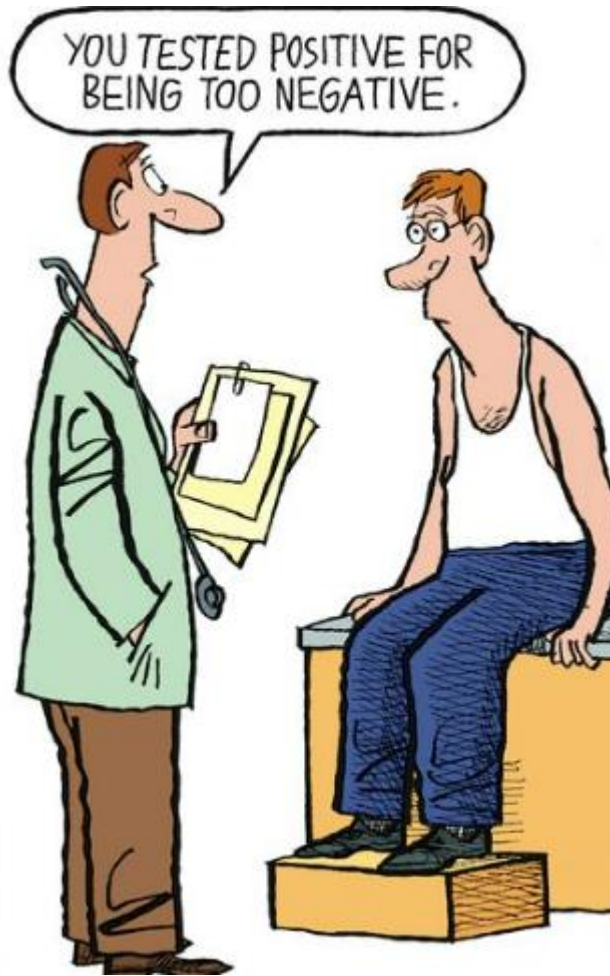

Dear Praying Friends,

In July the national pastor that served at the Mayorazgo Church for seven years resigned as God was calling him on to another ministry. We are grateful for the years of investment and for the seamless transition as I assumed the pastorate. The attendance has not faltered, and the energy has remained high. We are thankful for many mature leaders who have pitched in to help fill the gaps. While it was unexpected, we are sure that the Lord has orchestrated the circumstances. Please pray for us: our work load has increased as we added the responsibility of a thriving church to the direction of the Bible Baptist Seminary, the New Hope Camp, and co-laboring with the Editorial Sembrando Publishing House.

Recently our front gate at the Seminary property was vandalized. Robbery and extortion are common in our neighborhood. Crime in the area of the Seminary property has created a need for a security system that includes video monitoring. The cost of the system including cameras and installation will be \$5,000. We would be grateful if anyone would consider a special offering to help us care for the safety of our seminary students and professors.

Some of our church members have committed to expanding their evangelism opportunities. First, they have handed out evangelistic tracts every day. Some committed to 5 tracts per day while others have committed to 150 per week. They spend their lunch hour at work on a busy intersection of Lima to accomplish their goals. They have handed out 5,000 gospel tracts so far. Second, they have started a monthly Christian movie night at the church. There were 48 visitors from our community at the first event. May the Lord use these tools to draw men and women to Him.
