

#### NEPAL UPDATE

#### **DAVID AND KAREN FREEMAN**

**Dear Praying Friends,** 

We have been contacted several times in the past week about the situation here in Nepal. I would like to give a brief update on the terrible unrest in Kathmandu and the ramifications for our churches and believers.

On September 8<sup>th</sup>, protests against the government and corruption within the government started in Kathmandu. Those protesting were young people in their teens, twenties, and thirties. On September 9<sup>th</sup>, the crowds grew to over 100,000 in the streets of the city, and the police could no longer control the situation. The police killed 22 young people that day. That opened the door to anarchy, and the mob went through the city looting and burning almost all government buildings and the homes of all the government officials. Finally, on September 10<sup>th</sup>, the Nepali military took charge and stopped the rioting. Curfews remained in effect for over a week. Things are just now returning to normal.

We praise the Lord not one believer in any of our churches nationwide was harmed or injured in any way. Also, not one of our church buildings was targeted. Everyone is safe and doing as well as they can at this time. Because of the curfews imposed we were not able to have services for 2 weekends. However, we are now meeting as usual. Words cannot express how much we appreciate your prayers at this trying time for our churches.

This summer we did have 2 special meetings. One was a three-day youth meeting, and the second meeting was a two-day meeting for the ladies of the church. Both meetings dealt with being a Christian, as a young person or wife/mother, among unbelieving family and friends.

Thank you for your continued prayers and support.
