THE PRESENCE OF GOD'S GLORY (Exo 16:10-12c)

Exo 14:19-20 - And the *angel of God*, which went before the camp of Israel, removed and went behind them; and the pillar of the cloud went from before their face, and stood behind them: ²⁰ and it came between the camp of the Egyptians and the camp of Israel; and it was a cloud and darkness to them, but it gave light by night to these: so that the one came not near the other all the night.

Exo 16:6-7 - At even, then ye shall know that the Lord hath brought you out from the land of Egypt. ⁷ and in the morning, then ye shall see the glory of the Lord;

WHAT THEY SAW (Exo 16:10) behold, **the glory of the Lord** appeared in the cloud.

Exo 24:12-18 - the Lord said unto Moses, Come up to me into the mount, and be there: and I will give thee tables of stone, and a law, and commandments which I have written; that thou mayest teach them... ¹⁵ And Moses went up into the mount, and a cloud covered the mount. ¹⁶ And the glory of the Lord abode upon mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it six days: and the seventh day he called unto Moses out of the midst of the cloud. ¹⁷ And the sight of the glory of the Lord was like devouring fire on the top of the mount in the eyes of the children of Israel. ¹⁸ And Moses went into the midst of the cloud, and gat him up into the mount: and Moses was in the mount forty days and forty nights.

Exo 25-27 concerns the tabernacle.

Exo 28:1-43 the priest's clothing
worshippers must wash up (**Exo 19:10,14, 29:4**),
leaders of worship were ordered to dress up.

Exo 29-31 concerns the tabernacle.

Exo 32 worship of the golden calf and
Moses' intercession for the people of Israel.

Exo 33:18-23) Moses (Moses) said, I beseech thee, shew me thy glory. ¹⁹ And he (the Lord) said, I will make all my goodness pass before thee, ... ²⁰ And he said, Thou canst not see my face: for there shall no man see me, and live. ²¹ And the Lord said, Behold, there is a place by me, and thou shalt stand upon a rock: ²² and it shall come to pass, while my glory passeth by, that I will put thee in a clift of the rock, and will cover thee with my hand while I pass by: ²³ and I will take away mine hand, and thou shalt see my back parts: but my face shall not be seen.

Exo 34:29-35 And it came to pass, when Moses came down from mount Sinai with the two tables of testimony in Moses' hand, when he came down from the mount, that Moses wist not that the skin of his face shone while he talked with him. ... ³³ And till Moses had done speaking with them, he put a vail on his face. ³⁴ But when Moses went in before the Lord to speak with him, he took the vail off, until he came out.

WHAT GOD SAID (Exo 16:11-12) And the Lord spake unto Moses, saying,

GOD'S INVOLVEMENT (**Exo 16:12a**) I have heard the murmurings of the children of Israel:

Exo 16: 7, 8, 9, &12 ⁷God ... heareth your murmurings against the Lord: and what are we, that ye murmur against us? ⁸ And Moses said, ... the lord heareth your murmurings which ye murmur against him: and what are we? your murmurings are not against us, but against the Lord. ⁹ ... **Come near before the Lord: for he hath heard your murmurings.**

GOD'S INFORMATION (**Exo 16:12bc**) speak unto them, saying, At even ye shall eat flesh, and in the morning ye shall be filled with bread;

THE PURPOSE OF GOD'S GIFTS (Exo 16:12d) and ye shall know that I am the Lord your God.

Matt 4:1-4 (4) But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.
