MOSES' CRY TO GOD (15) *And the Lord said unto Moses, Wherefore criest thou unto me?*

WHERE THE ISRAELITES WERE

(Exo 13:21-22)

WHAT THE ISRAELITES WERE DOING

(waiting and worrying) Exo 14:10 *“when Pharaoh drew nigh, the children of Israel lifted up their eyes, and, behold, the Egyptians marched after them; and they were sore afraid: and the children of Israel cried out unto the Lord.”*

Exo 14:14 *“the Lord shall fight for you, and ye shall hold your peace.”*

GOD'S CALL TO MOSES (15b)

WORDS (15b)

(14) **To the People:**

“ye shall hold your peace.”

(15) **To Moses:**

“speak unto the children of Israel “

WALK (15) *that they go forward:*

WORK (16) *but lift thou up thy rod, and stretch out thine hand over the sea,*

PREPARATION (16a)

PROVISION (16bc)

Water (16b) *stretch out thine hand over the sea, and divide it:*

Ground (16c) *and the children of Israel shall go on dry ground through the midst of the sea.*

The miraculous work of God (16)

The practical work of God (17)

PROMISE (17) *And I, behold, I will harden the hearts of the Egyptians, and they shall follow them: and I will get me honor upon Pharaoh, and upon all his host, upon his chariots, and upon his horsemen.*

I will get me honor upon Pharaoh, (Exo 14:4, 17, 18)

Punishment

Penalty

PRINCIPLE (18) *And the Egyptians shall know that I am the Lord, when I have gotten me honor*

What is it that God wants?

(The honor He has earned and deserves – **Exo 20:2-7**)

How is God honored?

By being known by people His people (and the world)

By having His word (will) obeyed

By being worshipped...

He wants to be worshipped
on the 1st day of week

Acts 20:27- *upon the first day of the week*
1 Cor 16:1-2 - *upon the first day of the week*
Rev 1:10 – *I was in the Spirit on the Lord's Day*

He wants to be worshipped
by an assembled people

Heb 10:23-25 *“Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; ...²⁴ and let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: ²⁵ not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.*

He wants to be worshipped
with our finances

Lev 27:30 *“And all the tithe of the land, whether of the seed of the land, or of the fruit of the tree, is the Lord's: it is holy unto the Lord.”*

Mal 3:8 *“Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings.”*

1 Cor 16:2 *“Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, **as God hath prospered him**”*
