WHO SHE WAS (20a)
WHAT SHE DID (20b-21)
SHE PLAYED AN INSTRUMENT
(20b) *took a timbrel in her hand;*
SHE LED THE WOMEN (20c) *and*
all the women went out after her
SHE LED THEIR MUSIC (20c)
with timbrels
SHE LED THEIR CELEBRATION
(20d) *and with dances.*
SHE ENCOURAGED SINGING
TO THE LORD (21) *And Miriam answered them,*
Sing ye to the Lord, for he hath triumphed gloriously; the
horse and his rider hath he thrown into the sea.

Numbers 33:1-9

Exo 15:22-27 “

THE NEED OF WATER (15:22-27)
THE LONG WALK (22ab)
FROM THE RED SEA (15:22) *So Moses*
brought Israel from the Red Sea,
INTO THE WILDERNESS (15:22b) *and*
they went out into the wilderness of Shur; and they went
three days in the wilderness,

THE LACK OF WATER (15:22c) *found no water.*

THE LOSS OF HOPE - (15:23-26)
THE CRITICISM OF PEOPLE (23) *A*
RESULT OF UNMET EXPECTATIONS
THE COMPLAINT OF THE PEOPLE
(15:24) *And the people murmured against Moses,*
saying, What shall we drink?

THE CRY OF MOSES (15:25) *And he*
cried unto the Lord; and the Lord shewed him a
tree, which when he had cast into the waters, the waters
were made sweet: there he made for them a statute and
an ordinance, and there he proved them

THE COMMAND OF GOD (15:26) *and*
said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of
the Lord thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his
sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep
all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon
thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for
I am the Lord that healeth thee.

THE SWEETNESS OF ELIM (15:27) *And they*
came to Elim, where were twelve wells of water, and
threescore and ten palm trees: and they encamped
there by the waters.
